1. At the end of December 1948 General Francesco Zani reported to the heads of the PCI Apparatus of Bologna on the status of the para-military forces in the Emilia-Romagna area.

2. The report was given at a meeting held in the PCI Federation of Bologna on Via Barberia, Bologna. Among those present were:

Giuseppe Dozza - Communist mayor of Bologna and a member of the High Command of the PCI para-military forces in Emilia;

Arturo Colombi - A member of the PCI Central Committee and
former Regional Secretary of Emilia (now
transferred to Lombardy);

Mario Ricci alias Armando - Mayor of Pavullo and commander of the
partisans of the Modenese Apennines.

3. A report signed by Mario Tartari, PCI inspector, was also read at the
above-mentioned meeting. Tartari made an inspection tour of the Emilia-
Romagna, Le Marche and Tuscany regions. Tartari commended the work done
in the provinces of Bologna, Modena and Ferrara, however, he stated that
Ravenna and Forli were still unorganized. He recommended a substitution
of PCI Apparatus leaders in the latter provinces.
